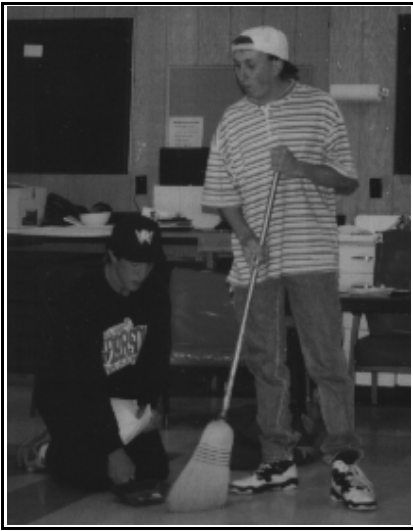


Amazing Progress at Camp Colorado



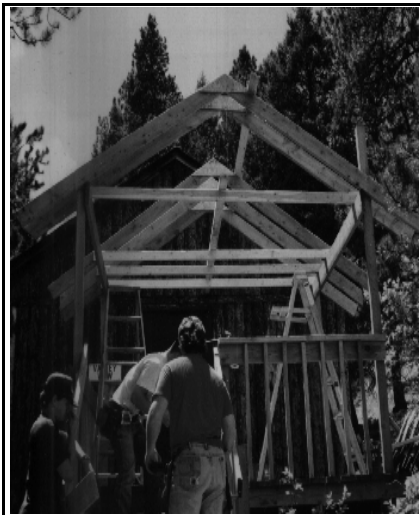

Western Plains adult work camp laid the groundwork for the National Senior High camp

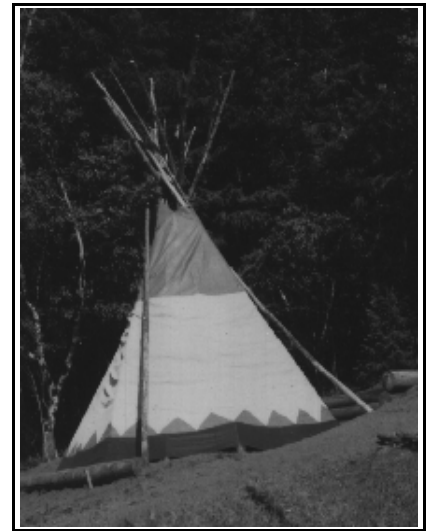

Long range projects completed included, the new men's 100X30 foot underground leech field, a new shutter system for the recreation building and dinning hall, the base for a 50' by 16' wooden deck to be completed at the

National Work Camp, volleyball court lighting system, Installed new propane gas tank and two propane water heaters in the women's bath. Hot water will be in abundance now and we expect that our electric bills will drop.



The largest **1995 National Senior High Work Camp** was held this year at Camp Colorado. With more than fifty in attendance from Pennsylvania, Illinois, Ohio, Florida, North Carolina, Michigan, Virginia, Indiana, California, Iowa and West Virginia. Projects included new dinning hall deck (16 X 50 with lights), installing a authentic Indian tepee, put roofs over the decks on Deer Tail & Valley View, installed two new horseshoe



pits, assembled new picnic tables, removed old beds, dug water channels on the road, painted doors, painted propane tanks, fixed steps, gathered wood, etc. The work camp included nightly meetings regarding Heifer Project, BVS and Forest Ranger presentations. We enjoyed meeting the Brethren youth from all over the United States and look forward to a Nat. Work Camp in the near future.
