

Camp Colorado Renters COVID Statement – Summer 2022

Every year post-COVID gives us new challenges and expectations as we work together for a safe and rejuvenating experience. We look forward to your engagement with the following items before the start of your rental period:

- Comply with all regulations and expectations as put forth by Douglas County, State of Colorado, and National Centers for Disease Control guidelines, as well as routine protocols previously established by Camp Colorado. You are responsible to check for updated regulations as these may change after the writing of this letter.

- Be aware that Camp Colorado does not require, but strongly encourages vaccination for your staff and campers.
- If staff or campers have symptoms of COVID, testing for COVID is encouraged but not required. If you provide any COVID testing during your time at camp, reporting these results is required by the state of Colorado. Please alert me well before the start of your camp to allow for training regarding reporting of results through the approved website.
- Sign and return the COVID waiver as attached below, which indicates your intention to adhere to national, state and local COVID regulations and renders Camp Colorado free from liability in the case of COVID infection during your rental period.
